CASE DISPOSITIONS:

C1000037 - SA Chesler cited a recreational fisher for retaining snapper-grouper within the Oculina Bank Experimental Closed Area. The case was initiated when the USCGC TAMPA observed the subject's vessel inside the closed area. A subsequent boarding outside of the area revealed a greater amberjack onboard. SAs Chesler and Fields interviewed the fisher who admitted to having the amberjack onboard within the closed area.

C1000531 - SA Chesler cited a recreational fisher for fishing for snapper-grouper within the Oculina Bank Experimental Closed Area. The case was initiated when the FL FWCC Patrol Vessel C.T. RANDALL boarded the vessel within the closed area.

MEDIA:

No Oculina specific media this quarter.

OUTREACH:

SA Chesler provided Oculina Bank and snapper-grouper regulations brochures to the organizers of the Blue Water Open Tournament out of Sebastian Inlet. The regulations were included in bags given to each captain participating in the tournament. The offshore tournament offered prizes for snapper-grouper, dolphinwahoo, king mackerel, and dolphin SA Chesler discussed Oculina Bank enforcement efforts with an anthropologist conducting a report for the Gulf & South Atlantic Fisheries Foundation. The report is an assessment of the impacts of the Oculina Bank Marine Protected Area and an in-depth ethnographic profile of the Fort Pierce, Florida fishing community.

SA Chesler provided a federal fisheries update to the Brevard Marine Advisory Council. The presentation gave an overview of OLE, snapper-grouper amendments 17A (red snapper) and 17B (deepwater SNG), Oculina Bank and Deepwater Coral HAPCs, dolphin feeding, and right whale close approach regulations.

SA Chesler gave a presentation on Oculina Bank HAPC enforcement at the Brevard Parks - Barrier Island Sanctuary. The presentation followed a lecture by sanctuary staff about the Oculina coral habitat. SA Chesler also distributed South Atlantic Fishery Management Council Oculina regulations and dolphin/MMPA brochures.

TRAINING:

SA Chesler presented a certificate of appreciation to FL FWCC Ofc. Ryan Smith for his support of federal fisheries enforcement in the Oculina Bank and Port Canaveral areas of Brevard County.

SA Chesler conducted a patrol of the Oculina Bank HAPC onboard the USCGC ZEPHYR (WPC 8). While enroute to the patrol area, SA Chesler provided training to the boarding team on Oculina Bank and Deepwater Coral HAPC regulations. No vessels were observed inside the area.

PATROL ACTIVITY HIGHLIGHTS:

- **1.** The FL FWCC Patrol Vessel *C.T. Randall* patrolled the OHAPC and OECA during the Spring Fling Tournament out of Sebastian Inlet. One recreational vessel was observed bottom fishing in the OECA which resulted in a federal citation (see case disposition above).
- 2. The USCG conducted patrols of the Oculina Bank using two cutters in September. Weather in the vicinity of the OHAPC was poor and no vessels were observed in or near the area.


NOTES:
