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APAIS change and Calibration

- Responding to NRC recommendations MRIP modified APAIS⁽¹⁾ in 2013
 - Sampling better distributed over the full day.
- Calibration of old to new and new to old estimates required for assessment and management
- Calibration WS Report April 2015 recommended
 - Interim calibration
 - Evaluate 3 methods when sufficient data available (interpreted as 3 or more years)
- (1) APAIS –Access Point Angler Intercept Survey



Calibration Activity and Plans

- Preliminary calibrations
 - for 2015 assessments (red snapper, red grouper, gray triggerfish, vermilion snapper)
 - used the interim approach

- SEFSC and SERO will investigate interim calibrations in Nov-Jan including
 - Multispecies / fishery based interim calibrations



Future Calibrations

- APAIS calibration
 - Investigate more complex calibration methods late 2016
 - Guidance expected early 2017
 - Incorporation in assessment and management 2017-2018
- FES (2)
 - Response to NRC review
 - Based on angler registries
 - Calibrations expected timelines
 - Development 2016-2017
 - Incorporation in assessment and management 2017-2018
- (2) FES Fishing Effort Survey
