SEDAR APPROVALS

The Committee discussed the Terms of Reference for the Red Snapper operational assessment (SEDAR 73). There was some concern with completing the stock assessment by April 2021 (SSC Meeting) with a proposed description of the model review listed in the Terms of Reference. The Terms of Reference were modified to ensure the SEDAR 73 would be available for review in April 2021 by the SSC. Outside of SEDAR, a separate selectivity workgroup will review the FWRI selectivity study to provide recommendation to SEDAR 73 and other South Atlantic stock assessments. The Committee discussed the statement of work for the meeting and recommended staff work with FWRI staff to develop the meeting. The Committee then discussed the Terms of Reference the Terms of Reference the SEDAR.
