The Committee last met September 2012.

3. <u>SEDAR ACTIVITIES</u>

The yellowtail snapper benchmark assessment was presented to, and accepted by, the Gulf of Mexico and South Atlantic SSC's during a joint meeting held October 10, 2012.

Update assessments of vermilion snapper and red porgy were presented to, and accepted by, the SAFMC SSC during its meeting October 23-25, 2012.

A Review Workshop was held for the South Atlantic stocks of SEDAR 28 during the week of October 29. These assessments are scheduled for presentation to the SSC in April 2013.

The Steering Committee met October 3, 2012 and developed an initial schedule for 2014 stock assessments.

Planning is underway for SEDAR 32, benchmark assessment of gray triggerfish and blueline tilefish, and SEDAR 36, standard assessment of snowy grouper, and a black sea bass update.

The current SEDAR project schedule is provided (Attachment 1). Note that this schedule was not updated following the last Steering Committee meeting. This is due to awaiting resolution of schedule issues with Gulf and Caribbean assessments.

4. <u>STEERING COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATIONS</u>

The Steering Committee met via conference call on October 3, 2012 to discuss the assessment schedule for 2014 and beyond. The draft meeting summary is provided (Attachment 2). The table below highlights schedule recommendations for South Atlantic stocks.

- Black Sea Bass Update: Presented to SSC 4/13; recommendations to Council 6/13
- SEDAR 32, blueline tilefish and gray trigger: Presented to SSC 10/13; recommendations to Council 12/13
- SEDAR 36, snowy grouper: Presented to SSC 10/13; recommendations to Council 12/13

The next Steering Committee meeting will be held in Spring 2013. Topics to discuss include the SEDAR project schedule and assessment productivity.

The Committee is asked to approve schedules and Terms of Reference for SEDARs 32, 36, and the black sea bass update (Attachments 3 - 6). SEDAR 32 appointments were considered at the September meeting (Attachment 7). At this time the Committee is asked to approve the RW chair and several additional data providers since identified, and to consider the request from the prior meeting for a recreational triggerfish representative. The schedules and Terms of Reference offered for consideration were reviewed by the SSC in October 2012.
