FINAL SUMMARY REPORT FROM THE SEDAR COMMITTEE

Charleston, SC September 15, 2014

The SEDAR Committee met September 15, 2014. It received reports on current SEDAR and Steering Committee activities, and discussed future SAFMC priorities and SEDAR procedures.

The Committee was briefed on SEDAR 41 data issues including DW panel recommendations from a webinar held September 11. A draft report from that webinar, provided to the Committee prior to the meeting, provides details on the issue. SEFSC Director Dr. Ponwith briefed the Committee on a process the Center intends to follow to address reporting issues, with the goal of having the issue resolved by the end of 2014. It includes peer review of a process for obtaining and evaluating data and a number of focus groups to better understand the nature of reporting issues. It was noted that state agencies may have information ancillary to the headboat program that may also be of use. Work on the SEDAR 41 benchmarks will be delayed while headboat reporting issues are resolved. At the December 2014 meeting the Council will receive an update on the resolution efforts and consider how to modify the schedule of SEDAR 41, including whether to include 2014 data. The Council will also determine how scheduling of other South Atlantic assessments will be adjusted.

The committee reviewed assessment priorities, and supported the June 2014 priorities with the addition of greater amberjack.
