3. Southeast For-Hire Integrated Electronic Reporting (SEFHIER) Program Improvement Amendment

(Attachments 3a and 3b)

Description: At the June 2024 meeting, the Council received feedback from the NOAA Fisheries Southeast Regional Office and Southeast Fisheries Science Center that data being collected through the SEFHIER program and for-hire logbook cannot be used for management due to low compliance and lack of validation. The letter included a list of recommendations to render the data collected through SEFHIER useful for management. The Council directed staff to initiate work on an amendment to address these shortcomings, including discussion of actions that can be taken in the near-term without an amendment, and consideration actions and alternatives being explored by the Gulf of Mexico Fishery Management Council. At the September 2024 the Council refined potential actions in the amendment.

Requested Action: Review background information and provide feedback to discussion questions at the end of the discussion document to provide guidance to the Council on initial considerations for improving for-hire reporting compliance.
