(i) During May and June, possession limited to 10 per person per day or per trip, whichever is more restrictive.
(j) NOAA Fisheries has temporarily removed blueline tilefish from the Deep-Water Complex. This temporary rule became effective on April 17, 2014, will be in place through October 14, 2014, and may be extended for an additional 186 days.
(k) The use of black sea bass pots is prohibited annually from November 1 through April 30.
