OVERVIEW

Snapper Grouper Committee

The Committee will approve the minutes from the June 2024 meeting and the agenda for the September 2024 Committee meeting.

Update on Exempted Fishing Permits (EFP) Red Snapper Projects

Description: Research projects testing alternative management strategies for reducing releases of red snapper by the recreational sector are being conducted in Florida under federal EFPs. Florida Fish and Wildlife Commission will provide a verbal update on the progress of these research projects.

Committee Action: None.

1. Gag and Black Grouper Recreational Vessel Limits and On-Demand Gear for Black Sea Bass (Regulatory Amendment 36; *Attachments 1a-1c*)

Description: Regulatory Amendment 36 considers revising the gag and black grouper recreational vessel limits and revising commercial black sea bass pot transit requirements to accommodate the use of on-demand black sea bass pots. In June 2024, the Council approved the amendment for public hearings, which were held via webinar on July 31 and August 1, 2024. Council staff will present the draft amendment using a decision document that outlines actions, alternatives, public comments, and effects analyses.

Committee Action: Review public comments, decision document, final draft document, and draft codified text and consider for final approval.

2. Black Sea Bass (SG Amendment 56) (SSC Report & Attachment 2)

Description: SEDAR 76 included data through 2021 and indicated that the black sea bass stock in the South Atlantic is at very low levels in recent years. In June 2023, the Council reviewed the Fishery Overview and initiated Amendment 56 to respond to the SEDAR 76 assessment results. In June 2024, the Council requested additional catch projections that incorporated management changes beyond changes to the annual catch limit to be developed by the Southeast Fisheries Science Center and reviewed by the SSC at their August 2024 meeting. The Council also approved the amendment for scoping and directed staff to conduct scoping after the September Council meeting to allow time for SSC review of the additional projections. The SSC met via webinar in August and discussed the additional projections with the analysts, clarifying the assumptions for the requested projections. The SSC is expected to review results of the projections at their October 2024 meeting. The SSC Chair will present the SSC's comments and recommendations from August 2024.

Committee Action: Review SSC comments and discuss potential timeline adjustments.

3. Scamp/Yellowmouth Grouper (SG Amendment 55) (Attachments 3a-3c)

Description: The results of SEDAR 68 were reviewed by the Council in March 2023 and staff were directed to start a plan amendment to reorganize the Other Shallow Water Grouper Complex, establish the new Scamp and Yellowmouth Grouper Complex and establish a rebuilding plan, catch levels, allocations and AMs for this new complex. During the June 2024 meeting, staff reviewed a decision document that included an effects summary for each action and AP feedback from the April 2024 Snapper Grouper AP meeting and a decision

tool. The Council selected the remaining preferred alternatives. During the September meeting the Council will review the final draft document, public comment, draft rationale, and codified text and will consider the amendment for final approval.

Committee Action: Review public comments, decision document, final draft document, and draft codified text and consider for final approval.

Description: The Snapper Grouper AP is scheduled to convene on October 15-17, 2024. Below is a list of proposed topics to develop the AP's agenda:

5. Other Business

Black Grouper Management Strategy Evaluation (SSC Report)

Description: The SSC reviewed a presentation from Nature Analytics on a proposed foundation for designing management procedure options for black grouper fisheries in the U.S. Southeast Region. The need for a stock assessment alternative occurred as a result of the termination of the last stock assessment for black grouper (SEDAR 48, 2017), due to a variety of issues that were raised in the data workshop, particularly with regard to the misidentification of black grouper and gag leading to uncertain landings time series data. The presentation provided by Nature Analytics aimed to provide a stock assessment alternative by illuminating a pathway to designing and testing management procedures to ultimately provide management advice for southeastern black grouper.
