Types of Data Collected

- Species catch and discard composition
 - Aggregate bag limit
- Fishing location and effort
- Biological data
- Fishing behavior and angler satisfaction
- Validation methods
 - Reporting app
 - Dockside intercepts
 - Camera system or at-sea observers



Quarter 2: Project Statistics

- November – January
- 192 completed Fleet trips
- 132 dockside intercepts
- 1,572 red snapper harvested
 - 1,320 red snapper sampled



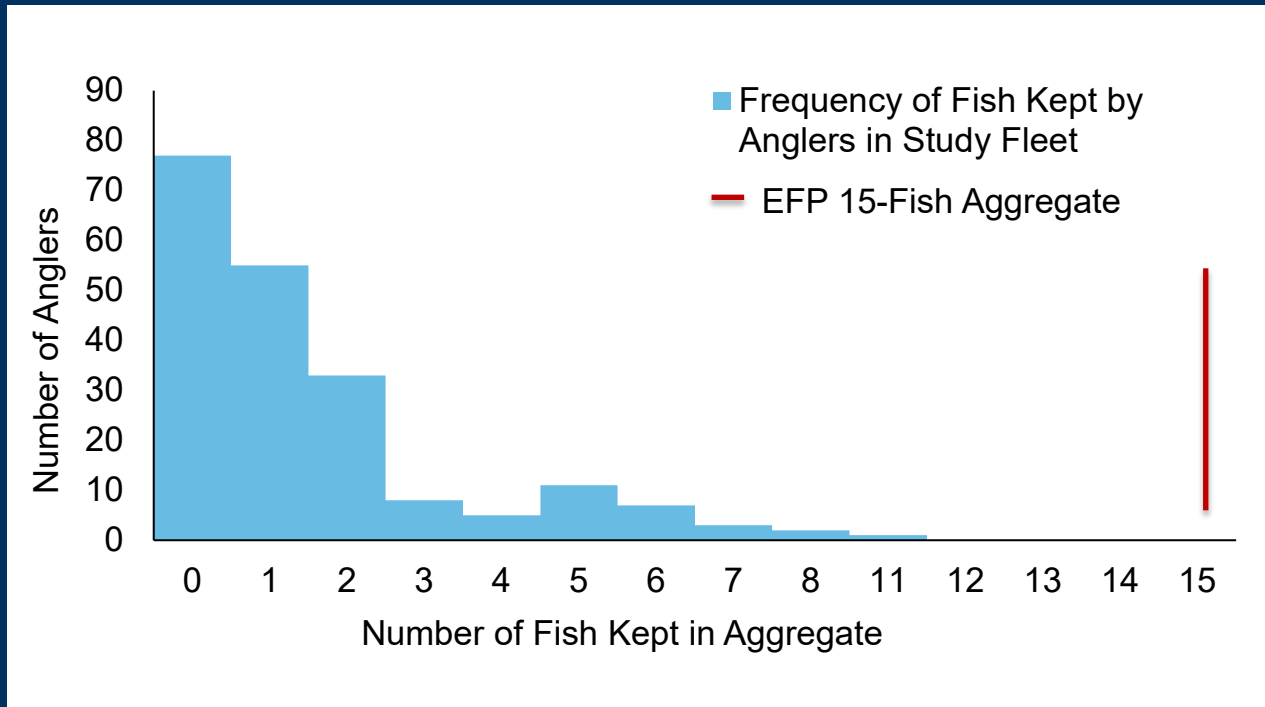

- Positive feedback with high interest

- Most anglers limiting out on red snapper before reaching aggregate bag limit
- Anglers prefer FWC's EFP management over closures
