OVERVIEW

Snapper Grouper Commercial Sub-Committee

1. Review of Updated Commercial Data Analyses (Attachment 1)

In March 2025, Council staff presented a report that analyzed landings for the top 10 commercially-landed snapper grouper species. The Sub-Committee requested an expansion of these analyses to include additional snapper grouper species, the number and length of commercial trips over time, breakdowns of landing and effort information by state, and commercial discard information from observers. Council staff will present the updated report for the Sub-Committee's consideration in developing management actions.

Sub-Committee Action: None.

2. Amendment 60 (Commercial Permits and Trip Efficiency) (Attachment 2)

In March 2025, the Council initiated an amendment to consider revisions to commercial permit policies as well as management measures that would improve commercial trip efficiency. Staff will present a draft timeline for the amendment, potential actions that have been discussed thus far, and discuss questions that could be used to elicit public input through scoping.

Sub-Committee Action: Review the draft timeline and potential actions. Discuss public input that is needed for further amendment development. Consider recommending approval for scoping.
