Snapper Grouper Recreational Permitting and Reporting Technical Advisory Panel Comments and Recommendations

At their June 2022 meeting the Council provided the following guidance for the AP:

"Convene a meeting of the Recreational Permitting and Reporting AP before the September 2022 SAFMC meeting. Direct the AP to review the Mid-Atlantic recreational tilefish reporting program with consideration of its applicability to the South Atlantic snapper grouper complex. Present AP recommendations at the September 2022 SAFMC meeting."

To help facilitate comments and development of recommendations, the following discussion questions are offered to the AP:

1) Could the Mid-Atlantic's approach to private recreational permitting and reporting be used to develop similar requirements in the Snapper Grouper fishery?

a. Permit Requirement:

- i. What are the considerations for implementing the permit?
- ii. How could such a permit be made most useful to address data deficiencies?

b. Reporting Requirement

- i. What are the considerations for implementing reporting requirements?
- ii. How could reporting requirements be made most useful to address data deficiencies?

c. Data:

- i. Is there additional information that should be captured in reporting?
- ii. Is there data captured that is not necessary for Snapper Grouper species the South Atlantic?
- 2) What species from the Snapper Grouper complex would be most applicable to the Mid-Atlantic's private recreational tilefish <u>permit</u> approach? (i.e. specific species, deepwater complex, all species, etc.?)
- 3) What species from the Snapper Grouper complex would be most applicable to the Mid-Atlantic's private recreational tilefish <u>reporting</u> approach? (i.e. specific species, deepwater complex, all species, etc.?)
- 4) What information is available to determine the number of anglers and potential permits desired?
- 5) Should reporting and permitting requirements be linked and imposed at the same time?
- 6) Should permitting and reporting requirements apply to all SG species and fishing effort?
- 7) Can data collected via permits and reporting be integrated with existing monitoring programs to add to the value of those efforts and reduce reporting burdens?
