

2.2. **Summary**

The projects report (Attachment 3) provides a summary of current and recently completed SEDAR assessment projects.

Highlighted project developments:

- The timing of some of the assessments finalized during the May SEDAR Steering Committee meeting was adjusted after the July SEDAR SEFSC planning call. Adjustments to the proposed schedule were required to alleviate data delivery conflicts for all projects approved for 2020.
- SA SSC MRIP Workshop: The SA SSC held a workshop to discuss the revised MRIP estimates in August 2019. The SSC was provided with in-depth presentations on the revised survey methods and calibration approach. The SSC supported using fully calibrated estimates in the upcoming assessments.
- Dr. Clay Porch will provide an update on the SEFSC data handling improvements.

MEETING OUTCOME

Chairman Porch provide the Committee an update on the SEFSC data handling improvements underway. He indicated that the projects are moving along well and that

they hope to go live with the new data automation process in 2021. These improvements should allow the Center to be able to handle an increased data load beginning in 2022.

3.2. **Summary**

The SEFSC requested that each cooperator provide a statement of work for the 2021 operational assessments (Attachment 5). SEFSC will report on the SOWs and workload outlook, and the Committee is asked to finalize priorities for 2021 and recommend priorities for 2022.

Priorities for 2019 – 2023 are shown in Table 1. This table reflects project timing resulting from the July 29 SEDAR-SEFSC project planning call.

MEETING OUTCOME

The Committee reviewed future assessment project priorities and finalized assessment projects for 2021. Recommendations are shown in Table 1, found at the front of this report with the summarized findings and recommendations.

2021 Workplan

The SEFSC requested that the SAFMC consider changing the 2021 red snapper Research Track to an Operational Assessment. They believed that all of the concerns raised by the SSC and Council could be evaluated within an Operational Assessment Framework. The SAFMC representatives on the webinar supported the change.

Chair Porch indicated that analytical resources are adequate for the requested projects, but there is a possibility of a limitation due to data resources. However, at this time the plan appears feasible and was approved for further development of project milestones and schedules.

2022 Workplan

The Committee identified preliminary projects for 2022. These will be finalized at the Spring 2020 meeting. Councils were requested to provide statements of work for all potential 2022 operational assessments to the SEFSC by March 2, 2020.

Future Priorities and Workload Planning

Cooperators are requested to identify their assessment priorities for 2023-2025 for further consideration and discussion at the Spring 2020 Steering Committee meeting. Although interim analyses are not a SEDAR project, they will need to be considered in SEFSC workload planning.

4. Other Business

MEETING OUTCOME

Summary of modifications to Planning Table between Steering Committee meetings:

There was a request from one Cooperator for staff to provide a summary of modifications that may occur to the Planning Table between the Draft Meeting Report for one meeting (for example Sept 2019) and the Planning Table that can be found in the Briefing Book materials for the next meeting (for example the May 2020 meeting). This request was put forward in the following motion:

Motion: Request that modifications to the SEDAR schedule overview table between Steering Committee meetings be summarized and distributed with the meeting summary materials (e.g., Section 3. Assessment Schedule Review).

Motion passed without objection

The Committee discussed possible ways to accommodate this request, and agreed that SEDAR Staff will develop a way to summarize modifications and make it available for the next meeting.

Possible ways to improve communications with data providers:

Chairman Porch informed the Committee that issues have arisen in the past where groups or individuals with data were not aware of upcoming or ongoing assessments in a timely manner. He asked the Committee to think about ways to improve communication will all potential data partners earlier in the process. This topic will be discussed further at the May Steering Committee meeting.

5. Next Meeting

The Committee is asked to make a scheduling recommendation and suggest topics for the next meeting. Based on past practices, this meeting will be held in-person in Charleston SC in May 2020.

MEETING OUTCOME

The Committee indicated that a number of meetings were already scheduled for that month, the next SEDAR Steering Committee meeting would need to be held the week of May $18\text{th}\,2020$.
