\*Originally, the 2017/2018 commercial quota for Atlantic migratory group Spanish mackerel northern zone was 662,670 pounds. However, regulations allow for quota transfers between the northern and southern zones with the approval from the Regional Administrator of NOAA Fisheries to allow the commercial quota for both zones to be fully harvested. 100,000 pounds of Spanish mackerel were transferred from the southern zone quota to the northern zone quota. Therefore, **the revised quotas are 2,567,330 pounds for the southern zone and 762,670 pounds for the northern zone.** The commercial sector in the Northern Zone closed on November 7, 2017.

**Cobia**

Preliminary landings of cobia from the SEFSC Quota Monitoring System as of February 12, 2018. Fishing year begins January 1.

Atlantic Group Quota for 2016 and 2017= 50,000 lbs

Florida East Coast Quota = 70,000 lbs

Commercial harvest for cobia was closed on September 5, 2017.
