### Notes on Landings Data

- Landings are summarized using MRIP or MRFSS (calibrated from MRIP) depending on how the ACL is calculated.
- Landings estimates were updated by NMFS SERO to be consistent with ACL monitoring (e.g., poststratification of estimates) and include data through wave 4, 2017
- All 2017 landings are preliminary






