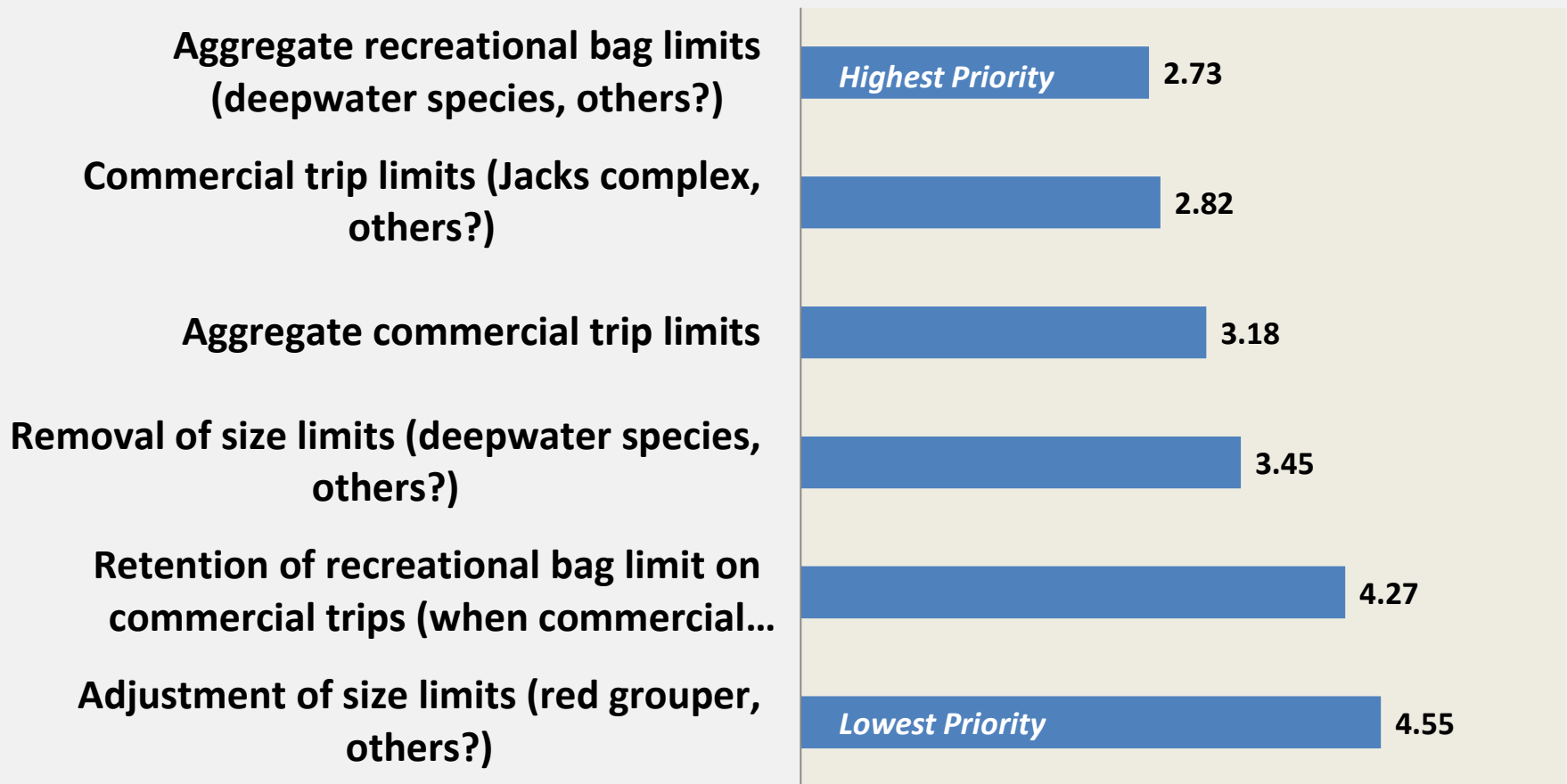

(scoping was done in August 2015 on 3 items)

Proposed Action:	Analysis to Date:
Change to fishing year for Hook-and-Line golden tilefish	SERO did an evaluation of season length based on alternatives in a paper dated August 20, 2015.
Commercial trip limit for Jacks Complex	SERO did some trip limit analyses for the Complex with and without greater amberjack.
Black sea bass bag limit	Moved to Regulatory Amendment 25
