South Atlantic Snapshot

- ≻211 Opened Incidents
- ≻7 Cases referred to General Counsel/US DOJ
- ≻24 Summary Settlements (\$250-\$2700)
 - ➢ Retention during closure/undersize possession
 - ➤TED/BRD Requirements
 - >Observer Program Requirements
- Remaining were unfounded, boardings, fix-its, compliance assistance or WWs.
