

Atlantic King Mackerel

Expanded landings of Atlantic king mackerel from the Southeast Fisheries Science Center (SEFSC) Quota Monitoring System as of November 16, 2021.

Fishing year begins March 1.

 - Southern Zone Quota Season 1 (March 1-September 30): 2,170,272 lbs.

Recent Closures:

- *FY 2018/2019*: the commercial sector in the Northern Zone closed on November 4, 2018. The commercial sector for the Southern Zone closed on February 5, 2019.
 - The trip limit for the Atlantic Spanish mackerel in the Southern Zone was reduced to 1,500 and 500 lbs. on December 26, 2018, and January 27, 2019, respectively.
- *FY 2019/2020*: the commercial sector in the Northern Zone closed on August 24, 2019. The commercial sector in Southern Zone did not experience a closure.
 - The trip limit for the Atlantic Spanish mackerel in the Southern Zone was reduced to 1,500 and 500 lbs. on December 24, 2019, and January 29, 2020, respectively.
- *FY 2020/2021*: the commercial sector in the Northern Zone was closed on July 22, 2020. The commercial sector for the Southern Zone closed on February 3, 2020.
 - No trip limit step downs took place during the 2020/2021 season.
- *Current FY 2021/2022*: the commercial sector in the Northern Zone closed on June 28, 2021. The commercial sector in the Southern Zone remains open.
